

USING WITH NOKIA 6310i

a. ACTIVATING THE BLUETOOTH

You must activate your Bluetooth to establish a Bluetooth connection between your mobile phone and other Bluetooth devices.

1. Press the *Menu* button. Scroll to *Bluetooth*, **SELECT**. Press **SELECT** again.
2. Choose *On*, **SELECT**. An icon will appear on the upper left corner.
3. Press *Back* then *Exit* to exit the *Menu*.

QUICK ACCESS:

Press *Menu* followed by the sequence of numbers below.

b. PAIRING TO THE CELLULAR PHONE

1. Bring the cellular phone at about 20 cm from the car kit.
2. Press the multi-function button for 10 seconds or until a distinctive three-tone sound will be heard and at the same time the red and blue indicator will alternately blink. This indicates that the car kit is now ready for pairing.
3. Press the *Menu* button. Scroll to *Bluetooth*, **SELECT**. Scroll to *Search for audio accessories*, **SELECT**. The phone is now scanning for Bluetooth devices. **SELECT** the device. The phone will initiate connection with the car kit.

QUICK ACCESS (for step 3):

Press *Menu* followed by the sequence of numbers below.

	Blue tooth	Search for audio accessories

4. Enter "0000" as the passcode then press **OK**. The phone is now connected with the car kit.
5. Press *Back* then *Exit* to exit the *Menu*.

The car kit is paired and ready to use. An icon will be displayed during the standby mode indicating that the car kit is linked with the phone.

Note: Once paired, the car kit and the phone have simultaneous connection with each other (keypad tones can be heard on the car kit every time the keypad is pressed).

c. AUTO ACCEPT MODE

The auto accept mode allows the Bluetooth function to be turned on automatically whenever the user starts sending information such as answering or making a call via the Bluetooth car kit.

1. Press the *Menu* button. Scroll to *Bluetooth*, **SELECT**. Scroll to *View paired devices*, **SELECT**.
2. Select the device and press **OPTIONS**. Scroll to *Request conn. authorisation*, **SELECT**. *No*, **SELECT**.
3. Continue pressing *Back* button to exit the *Menu*.

QUICK ACCESS:

Press *Menu* followed by the sequence of numbers below.

d. ANSWERING/RECEIVING A CALL

When the phone is receiving a call, a ring tone will be heard on the car kit as well as on the phone.

1. Press the multi-function button down once to answer the call.
2. End the call by pressing the button again.

Note: Cell phone buttons can also be used to answer a call but audio is still transferred to the car kit.

e. **MAKING A CALL with the car kit on**

▼ **Normal dialing**

1. Enter the contact number and send. As you dial, audio and the keypad tones can be heard on the car kit simultaneously but not on the phone.
2. Press the multi-function button to hang-up and terminate the call.

Note: If the call is terminated using the cellular phone, a tone will be heard on the car kit indicating that the call has been terminated.

▼ **Voice dialing**

Refer to step f for the procedure when recording for voice dialing.

1. Press the multi-function button once to activate the voice dialing.
2. A beep will then be heard on the car kit prompting the user to say the name of the person to call.
3. Say the name. The name will be played back to you. The phone will then place the call automatically. In case the cellular phone does not recognize the name spoken, the steps above may be repeated.
4. Press the button again to terminate the call.

f. **RECORDING FOR VOICE DIALING**

Use your phone when recording voice dialing.

1. Press the *Names* button. *Search*, **SELECT**. Press *List* button.
2. Find a contact name. Press *Details* button.
3. Press *Options* button. *Add voice tag*, **SELECT**. Instructions appear. Your voice is automatically saved on the phone after being played back to you.
4. In case you wish to change your recorded voice, press *Options* button. *Voice tags*, **SELECT**. *Change*, **SELECT**. Instructions appear.
5. Continue pressing *Back* button to exit.

Note: Record your voice command in a quiet place so that only your voice will be recorded on the phone.
