

USING WITH SIEMENS S55

a. ACTIVATING THE BLUETOOTH

You must activate your Bluetooth to establish a Bluetooth connection between your mobile phone and other Bluetooth devices.

1. Press the *Menu* button. Scroll to *Setup*, **SELECT**. Choose *Connectivity*, **SELECT**.
2. Scroll to *Bluetooth*, **Change**. The phone is now connecting with the Bluetooth device. An icon will appear on the upper left corner when connected. **OPTIONS** button may also be pressed. Choose *Activate BT*, then **SELECT**.
3. Continue pressing the *On/Off/End Key* to exit the *Menu*.

QUICK ACCESS:

Press *Menu* followed by the sequence of numbers below. Doing this sequence once will either activate or deactivate the Bluetooth depending on your current setting.

b. PAIRING TO THE CELLULAR PHONE

1. Bring the cellular phone at about 20 cm from the car kit.
2. Press the multi-function button for 10 seconds or until a distinctive three-tone sound will be heard and at the same time the red and blue indicator will alternately blink. This indicates that the car kit is now ready for pairing.
3. Press the *Menu* button. Scroll to *Setup*, **SELECT**. Choose *Connectivity*, **SELECT**. Scroll to *Bluetooth*, **OPTIONS**. Scroll to *Search for...*, press **ACCESS** button. The phone is now searching for devices. When the search is complete, *Devices disc.* is displayed as title. If the device you are looking for is not on the list, repeat the procedure by pressing the **OPTIONS** and **REPEAT** buttons. Then press **SELECT** to add the device. The phone will initiate connection with the car kit.
4. *Pls, enter BT pin for...*, **OK**. Enter "0000" as the BT pin then press **OK**. car kit *trusted* will be displayed afterwards indicating that the pairing is completed.
5. Continue pressing the *On/Off/End Key* to exit the *Menu*.

The car kit is paired and ready to use. An icon will be displayed during the standby mode indicating that the car kit is linked with the phone.

c. ANSWERING/RECEIVING A CALL

When the phone is receiving a call, a ring tone will be heard from the phone.

1. Press the multi-function button down once to answer the call.
2. End the call by pressing the button again.

Note: Cell phone buttons can also be used to answer a call. To transfer the call to the car kit, press the multi-function button once.

d. MAKING A CALL with the car kit on

☛ Normal dialing

1. Enter the contact number and send. To transfer audio on the car kit, press the multi-function button once.
2. Press the multi-function button again to hang-up and terminate the call.

Note: If the call is terminated using the cellular phone, no tone will be heard on the car kit indicating that the call has been terminated.

☛ Voice dialing



Refer to step e for the procedure when recording for voice dialing.

1. Press the multi-function button once to activate the voice dialing.

2. A beep will then be heard on the car kit prompting the user to say the name of the person to call.
3. Say the name. The name will be played back to you. The phone will then place the call automatically. In case the cellular phone does not recognize the name spoken, the steps above may be repeated.
4. Press the button again to terminate the call.

e. **RECORDING FOR VOICE DIALING**

Use your phone when recording for voice dialing. Record your contact names and numbers in the "Address book" (phone memory).

1. From standby mode, open the *Address book* by pressing the arrow down key . (If Phone book is the one displayed, press  key to switch to Address book.)
2. Select a contact name. **OPTIONS.**
3. Scroll to *Voice dialing*, **SELECT.** *New*, **SELECT.** *Recording for: contact name*, **YES.** Follow the instructions. Your voice is automatically saved on the phone after being played back to you.
4. In case you wish to change your recorded voice, press *Options* button. *Voice tags*, **SELECT.** *Change*, **SELECT.** Instructions appear.
5. Press *On/Off/End* key to exit

Note: Noisy environment may affect voice recognition. Record your voice in a quiet place.
