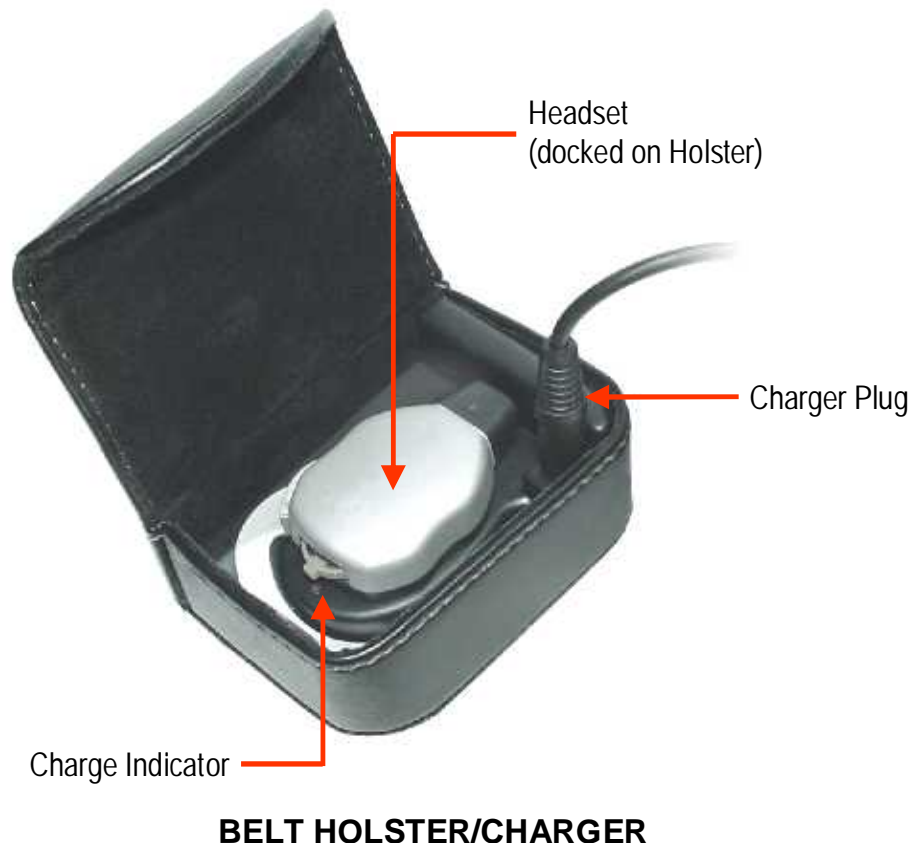
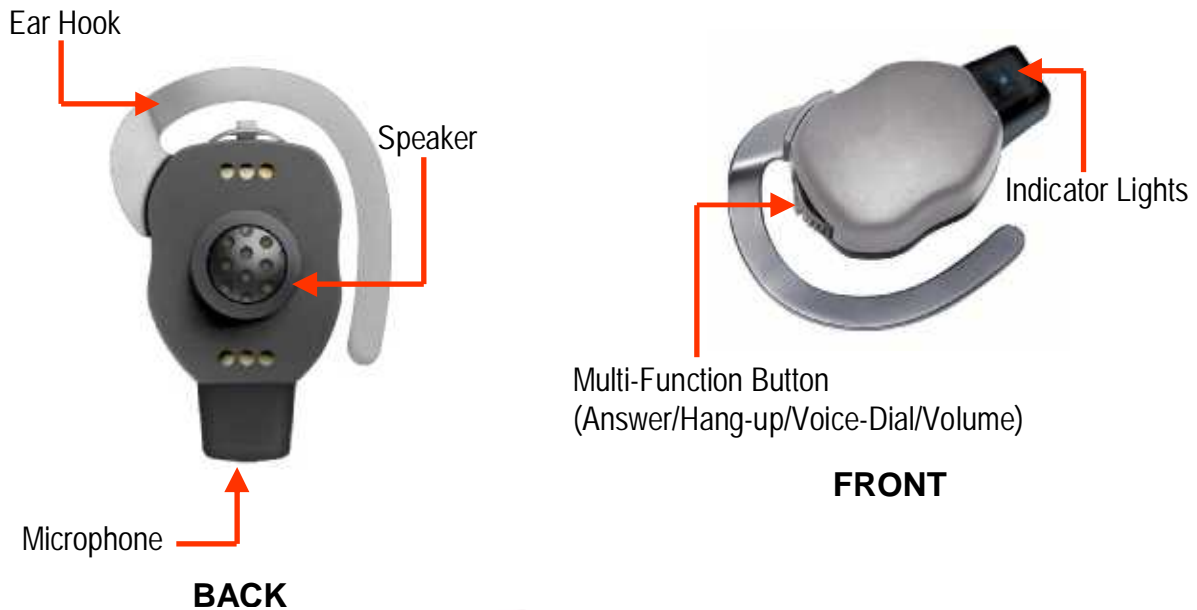

OVERVIEW

This Headset uses Bluetooth technology that allows wireless communications among devices such as cellular phones. This is designed to be a totally wireless Headset that enables the user to answer or make a call without having to get the phone from the bag, pocket or belt clip. This provides convenience to the user by communicating freely, without holding the phone, thus, ideal when driving, working or jogging, etc. This device works on all Bluetooth cellular phones provided that they respect the Bluetooth protocol.

BACK

Note: The Headset turns on automatically once docked on the charger. The *Charge Indicator* emits three different light modes. *Red* indicates that the Headset is charging. When the Headset has fully charged, *Green* and *Red* lights will alternately blink. Once the Headset is removed, the charge indicator turns *Green* (standby mode).

A. TURNING ON/OFF THE HEADSET

1. To turn the Headset ON, press the multi-function button for 2 seconds. A low-high tone will then be heard and a blue light will show.
2. Release the button and the indicator light will blink. The Headset is now ready and is waiting for a call (standby mode).
Note: If the indicator becomes red, it means that the battery on the Headset is low. Re-charge it immediately by docking it on the belt holster/charger.
3. To turn the Headset OFF, press the multi-function button for more than 4 seconds or more depending on the phone. A high-low tone will then be heard and the indicator light becomes red then turns off after a few seconds.
4. Wait at least 4 seconds before turning the Headset ON again.

REMARKS:

- § When the cell phone is not detected for more than 5 minutes, if used as a stand-alone Headset or docked and no power from the Cigarette Lighter Jack, it will turn off automatically thus, conserve battery life.
- § The Headset can be turned off during charging.

B. HEADSET OPERATIONS

Before use, the Headset must be paired with the phone. This Headset requires either of the two pairing modes (Handsfree or Headset) which you will select depending on your cellular phone. Please refer to “**Suggested Pairing Modes**” on page 6. Pairing is done only once. After being paired, the phone and the Headset becomes connected. You can answer or make a call using the Headset instead of your phone. (For the instructions, please refer to “**USING THE HEADSET WITH YOUR CELLULAR PHONES**” on page 7).

Important Remarks:

- On some versions of Nokia's software, the Headset will not connect automatically to the cell phone. You will need to do one press on the multi-function button to connect it to the cell phone.
- If disconnection problem will be encountered on some Nokia cell phones, kindly turn off the keypad tone of your cell phone.

Handsfree Pairing

- From the OFF state, press the multi-function button for 10 seconds or until a distinctive three-tone sound will be heard and at the same time the red and blue indicator will alternately blink.

Headset Pairing

- From the OFF state, press the multi-function button for 10 seconds or until a distinctive three-tone sound will be heard and at the same time the red and blue indicator will alternately blink.
- Press the multi-function button again for a short time to access Headset Pairing Mode.

USING WITH SONY ERICSSON T39m

a. ACTIVATING THE BLUETOOTH

You must activate your Bluetooth to establish a Bluetooth connection between your mobile phone and other Bluetooth devices.

1. Press *Menu*. Scroll to *Extras* and press **YES**. Select *Operation mode*, **YES**. On, **YES**.
2. Continue pressing **NO** to exit.

Press *Menu* followed by the sequence of numbers below.

b. PAIRING TO THE CELLULAR PHONE

Pairing will create a link or connection between your two Bluetooth devices, the Headset and your phone.

1. Bring the cellular phone at about 20 cm from the Headset.
2. Detach the Headset from the holster/base.
3. Ensure that the Headset is turned off (see *B.Turning On/Off the Headset*).
4. From the OFF state, press the multi-function button for 10 seconds until you hear a distinctive three-tone sound and the Bluetooth indicator LED changes from blinking blue to alternately blinking red and blue. This indicates that the unit is now ready for pairing.
5. **Press the multi-function button once again for a short time, to access headset pairing mode.**
6. Press *Menu Key*. Scroll to *Extras*, **YES**. Select *Bluetooth*, **YES**. Select *Paired devices*, **YES**. Add device, **YES**. Choose *Phone initiates*, **YES**. Choose *Headset*, **YES**. The phone will then search the device to be added. After the device is found, press **YES**.

Press *Menu* then follow the sequence of numbers below:

7. Enter "0000" as the passkey. If the pairing is successful, the alternating red/blue lights will stop. Press **YES** to confirm the name of the device. If the pairing is unsuccessful, the steps above may be repeated.
8. Continue pressing **NO** to exit from Menu.

The unit is now ready to link calls from the phone directly to the Headset.

c. ANSWERING/RECEIVING A CALL

When the phone is receiving a call, a ring tone will be heard on the Headset.

1. Press the multi-function button once to answer the call. Pressing the button again will hang-up and terminate the call.
2. If you wish to answer the call on the cellular phone, press **YES**. Audio will be on the phone. Press the multi-function button once to transfer audio to the Headset.
3. To terminate the call, do the same as answering the call. Press the multi-function button once.

d. MAKING A CALL with the Headset on



Normal dialing

1. Enter the contact number and press **YES**. Audio can be heard on the Headset. Simultaneously, a question "*Retrieve call in phone?*" will be displayed. Ignoring or pressing *No*, will retain the audio to the Headset. Pressing *Yes*, will transfer the audio to the cell phone.

2. Press the multi-function button to hang-up and terminate the call.



Voice dialing

Refer to step g and h for the procedure when activating and recording for voice dialing.

1. Press the multi-function button once to activate the voice dialing.
2. A beep will then be heard on the Headset prompting the user to say the name of the person to call.
3. Say the name. The name will be played back to you. The phone will then place the call automatically. In case the cell phone does not recognize the name spoken, the steps above may be repeated.
4. Press the button again to terminate the call.

e. **AUDIO TRANSFER**

Audio Transfer can be done by pressing the multi-function button or accessing the cell phone's menu during ongoing calls.

f. **SETTING THE VOLUME**

The Headset has a digital volume control which can be accessed through the *multi-function button*. Volume setting can be done during calls only.

1. Switch the multi-function button sideways in a clockwise direction to increase the volume.
2. Switch it counterclockwise to decrease the volume.
3. Continuous sideward switching of the multi-function button (*clockwise or counterclockwise*) can rapidly increase or decrease the volume. *If the volume set is too high, it can cause feedback (whistling sound), echo or background noise during calls on some cell phones.*

g. **ACTIVATING THE VOICE DIALING**

Use your phone when recording for the voice dialing. Before voice dialing, you must first turn on the name dialing function and record your voice. To turn voice dialing on and record number types:

1. Press *Menu Key*. Scroll to *Settings*, **YES**. *Voice control*, **YES**.
2. *Voice settings*, **YES**. *Voice dialing*, **YES**. Select *On*, **YES**.
3. Continue pressing **NO** to exit

2. Find a contact name and follow the instructions in the display. An icon will appear next to a contact name which has a voice command.
3. Continue pressing **NO** to exit.

1. Go to Menu by pressing the joystick. Scroll to *Connect*, **YES**. Select *Bluetooth*, **YES**. Select *Options*, **YES**. *Operation mode*, **YES**. *On*, **YES**.
2. Continue pressing **NO** to exit.

Pairing will create a link or connection between your two Bluetooth devices, the Headset and your phone.

1. Bring the cellular phone at about 20 cm from the Headset.
2. Detach the Headset from the holster/base.
3. Ensure that the Headset is turned off (see *B.Turning On/Off the Headset*).
4. From the OFF state, press the multi-function button for 10 seconds until you hear a distinctive three-tone sound and the Bluetooth indicator LED changes from blinking blue to alternate blinking of red and blue. This indicates that the unit is now ready for pairing.
5. **For T68 and T68i older versions, R6 and below, press the multi-function button once again for a short time, to access Headset Pairing Mode.**
6. Go to Menu by pressing the joystick. Scroll to *Connect*, **YES**. Select *Bluetooth*, **YES**.
7. Select *Paired devices*, **YES**. *Add device*, **YES**. Choose *Phone initiates*, **YES**. Choose *Headset/Handsfree*, **YES**. The phone will then search the device to be added. After the device is found, press **YES**.

8. Enter "0000" as the passkey. If the pairing is successful, the alternating red/blue lights will stop. Press **YES** to confirm the name of the device. If the pairing is unsuccessful, the steps above may be repeated.
9. Continue pressing **NO** to exit from Menu.

The unit is now ready to link calls from the phone directly to the Headset. An icon, will appear during the standby mode indicating that the Headset is linked with the phone.

c. ANSWERING/RECEIVING A CALL

When the phone is receiving a call, a ring tone will be heard on the Headset.

1. Press the multi-function button once to answer the call. Pressing the button again will hang-up and terminate the call.
2. If you wish to answer a call on the cellular phone, just press **YES** and the call will automatically be transferred to the phone. Pressing the multi-function button transfers the call on the Headset.
3. To terminate the call, press the multi-function button again.

Redialing

For T68i R6 and R7, press the multi-function button twice quickly. Audio will be heard on the Headset.

e. **AUDIO TRANSFER**

Audio Transfer can be done by pressing the multi-function button or accessing the cell phone's menu during ongoing calls.

f. **REJECTING A CALL**

For T68i R6 and R7, press the multi-function button twice quickly to reject the incoming call.

g. **SETTING THE VOLUME**

The Headset has a digital volume control which can be accessed through the *multi-function button*. Volume setting can be done during calls only.

1. Switch the multi-function button sideways in a clockwise direction to increase the volume.
2. Switch it counterclockwise to decrease the volume.
3. Continuous sideward switching of the multi-function button (*clockwise or counterclockwise*) can rapidly increase or decrease the volume. *If the volume set is too high, it can cause feedback (whistling sound), echo or background noise during calls on some cell phones.*

Note: It is also possible to use the volume keys of the cellular phone to set the volume.

a. **ACTIVATING THE BLUETOOTH**



You must activate your Bluetooth to establish a Bluetooth connection between your mobile phone and other Bluetooth devices.

1. Flip open mode. On the phone's **Applications** window, scroll to **Control Panel** and tap it using the "stylus". On the lower portion, tap **Connections** index. Tap **Bluetooth**. Tap **Settings** index. On the **Operation mode**, tap **On**.
2. Tap  to exit and return to the Applications window.

b. **PAIRING TO THE CELLULAR PHONE**

Pairing will create a link or connection between your two Bluetooth devices, the Headset and your phone.

1. Bring the cellular phone at about 20 cm from the Headset.
2. Detach the Headset from the holster/base.
3. Ensure that the Headset is turned off (see *B. Turning On/Off the Headset*).
4. From the OFF state, press the multi-function button for 10 seconds until you hear a distinctive three-tone sound and the Bluetooth indicator LED changes from blinking blue to alternately blinking red and blue. This indicates that the unit is now ready for pairing.

5. **Press the multi-function button once again for a short time, to access Headset Pairing Mode.**

8. On the lower left corner of the screen, tap . Enter "0000" as the passkey then tap **Done**. Also tap **Done** under the sub-title, "Secure Connection." If pairing is successful, the alternating red/blue lights will stop.
9. Tap  to exit and return to the **Applications** window. If the pairing is unsuccessful, the steps above may be repeated.

The unit is now ready to link calls from the phone directly to the Headset. An icon will appear during the standby mode indicating that the Headset is linked with the phone.

c. ANSWERING/RECEIVING A CALL

1. Just press the multi-function button down once to answer the call. Pressing the button again will hang-up and terminate the call.



1. Flip open mode. On the phone's **Applications** window, tap *Phone*.
2. Tap *Edit* then tap *Preferences*. A list of features will appear.
3. Tap *Voice Control* then tap the box aligned to *Voice dialing* to check and activate the voice dialing feature. Tap the box aligned to *Play caller name* so that the name will be played back to you.
4. Tap **Done** on the on screen button when finished.
5. On the Preferences mode, tap **Done** again.
6. Tap  to exit and return to the Applications mode.

h. RECORDING FOR VOICE DIALING

The voice dialing feature is only applicable to contacts saved to phone memory.


1. Flip open mode. On the phone's **Applications** window, tap *Contacts*.
2. Tap the contact where you want to add a voice dialing feature. Tap **Edit**. Scroll to **Edit Contact**. Tap  on the on-screen buttons.
3. Tap **Record**. *Speak after tone* will be displayed on the screen.
4. Record your voice. To check if your recording is of good quality, tap **Play**. If not, tap **Record** again. Press **Done** when finished.
5. Tap  to make another record and repeat the steps above. To return to the Applications window, tap  button.

Note: Noisy environment may affect voice recognition. Record your voice in a quiet environment.

USING WITH SONY ERICSSON T610

2. A beep will then be heard on the Headset prompting the user to say the name of the person to call.

4. Press the multi-function button again to terminate the call.

✦ **Redialing**

Press quickly the multi-function button twice to redial the last number.

f. **REJECTING A CALL**

Press the multi-function button twice to reject the incoming call.


g. **SETTING THE VOLUME**

1. Switch the multi-function button sideways in a clockwise direction to increase the volume.
2. Switch it counterclockwise to decrease the volume.

f. **SETTING THE VOLUME**

The Bluetooth setting is activated. Bluetooth icon  is displayed on standby mode screen.

b. **PAIRING TO THE CELLULAR PHONE**

Pairing will create a link or connection between your two Bluetooth devices, the Headset and your phone.

1. Bring the cellular phone at about 20 cm from the Headset.
2. Detach the Headset from the holster/base.






