

USING WITH NOKIA 8910

a. ACTIVATING THE BLUETOOTH

You must activate the Bluetooth feature of your phone to establish a Bluetooth connection between your cell phone and other Bluetooth devices.

1. Press *Menu*. Scroll to *Bluetooth*, **SELECT**. Press **SELECT** again.
2. Choose *On*, **SELECT**. An icon will appear on the upper left corner.
1. Continue pressing *Back* then finally *Exit*.

QUICK ACCESS:

Press *Menu* followed by the sequence of numbers below.

b. PAIRING TO THE CELLULAR PHONE (not possible while charging the Handsfree Kit)

Pairing will create a link or connection between your two Bluetooth devices, the Handsfree Kit and your phone.

1. Bring the cellular phone at about 20 cm from the Handsfree Kit.
2. Turn off the Handsfree Kit and wait for about 4 seconds.
3. While pressing the *Answer Button*, turn ON the Handsfree Kit by sliding the *Power Switch* to the right. Keep the Answer Button pressed for approximately 10 seconds until you hear a distinctive tone and the Bluetooth indicator LED changes from blinking blue to alternately blinking red and blue. The Handsfree Kit is now in pairing mode.
4. Press *Menu*. Scroll to *Bluetooth*, **SELECT** and *Search for audio accessories*, **SELECT**. The phone is now scanning for Bluetooth devices. **SELECT** the device. The phone will initiate connection with the Handsfree Kit.

QUICK ACCESS (for step 4):

Press *Menu* followed by the sequence of numbers below.

5. Enter "0000" as the passcode then press **OK**. The volume level will be displayed. The phone is now connected with the Handsfree Kit.
6. Press *Back* then *Exit*.

The Handsfree Kit is paired and ready to use. An icon will be displayed during the standby mode indicating that the Handsfree Kit is linked with the phone.

Note: Once paired, the Handsfree Kit and the phone have simultaneous connection with each other. (Keypad tones can be heard on the Handsfree Kit every time the keypad is pressed).

c. AUTO ACCEPT MODE

The auto accept mode allows the Bluetooth function to be turned on automatically whenever the user starts sending information such as answering or making a call via the Handsfree Kit.

1. Press **Menu**. Scroll to *Bluetooth*, **SELECT**. Scroll to *View paired devices*, **SELECT**.
2. Select the Handsfree Kit and press **OPTIONS**. Scroll to *Request conn. authorisation*, **SELECT**. *No*, **SELECT**.
3. Continue pressing *Back* button to exit the *Menu*.

QUICK ACCESS:

Press *Menu* followed by the sequence of numbers below.

d. **ANSWERING/RECEIVING A CALL**

When the phone is receiving a call, a ring tone will be heard on the Handsfree Kit as well as on the phone.

1. Shortly press the Answer Button to answer the call.

2. End the call by pressing the Hang-Up Button.

Note: Phone buttons can also be used to answer the call but audio will still be heard on the Handsfree Kit.

e. **MAKING A CALL with the Handsfree Kit on**

☛ **Normal dialing**

1. Enter the contact number and *Send*. As you dial, audio and the keypad tones will be heard on the Handsfree Kit but not on the phone.
2. Shortly press the Hang-Up Button to terminate the call.

☛ **Voice dialing**

Refer to step i for the procedure when recording for voice dialing.

1. Shortly press the Answer Button to activate the voice dialing.
2. A beep will then be heard on the Handsfree Kit prompting the user to say the name of the person to call.
3. Say the name. The name will be played back to you. The phone will then place the call automatically. In case the cellular phone does not recognize the name spoken, the steps above may be repeated.
4. Shortly press the Hang-Up Button to terminate the call.

☛ **Redialing**

Make a long press on the Answer Button to redial the last number.

f. **AUDIO TRANSFER**

Audio Transfer can be done by pressing the Answer Button or accessing the phone's menu during ongoing calls.

g. **REJECTING A CALL**

Shortly press the Hang-Up Button to reject an incoming call.

h. **SETTING THE VOLUME**

Setting the volume can be done using the Volume Control.

1. Turn clockwise to increase the volume.
2. Decrease the volume by turning it counter-clockwise.

Note: If volume set is too high, it can cause feedback (whistling sound), echo or background noise during calls.

i. **RECORDING FOR VOICE DIALING**

Voice dialing entries must be stored in the phone's memory (not on the SIM card!).

1. From standby mode, press arrow up or down.
2. Find a contact name to which you want to add a voice tag. Press *Details* button. The phone number will be displayed.
3. Press *Options* button. *Add voice tag*, **SELECT**. Press *Start*, and say the name clearly. *Voice tag saved* is displayed indicating that the voice tag has been saved.
4. In case you wish to change your recorded voice, press *Names*, *Voice tags*, **SELECT**. Scroll to the name whom you want to change the voice tag then press **Options**. *Change*, **SELECT**. Follow the instructions.
5. Continue pressing *Back* button to exit.

Note: Noisy environment could affect voice recognition. Record voice in a quiet environment.
