



## USING WITH SONY ERICSSON K700i



### ACTIVATING THE BLUETOOTH

You must activate the Bluetooth feature of your phone to establish a Bluetooth connection between your mobile phone and other Bluetooth devices.

1. Press  (Navigation key) to view Main Menu.
2. Select **Connectivity > Bluetooth > Turn On**. Bluetooth is turned on.
3. Press  as many times as needed to return to standby mode.

### PAIRING TO THE CELLULAR PHONE (not possible while charging the SuperTooth)

Pairing will create a link or connection between your two Bluetooth devices - the SuperTooth kit and your phone.

1. This SuperTooth kit supports either **Handsfree** or **Headset** pairing mode. First, refer to **Compatibility Table** for suggested pairing modes to be able to determine what pairing mode is best for your phone. **Handsfree** and **Headset** profile differs in pairing procedure. (*Note: In the Compatibility Table, you can find that Sony Ericsson K700i doesn't belong to Handsfree or Headset Pairing mode. It belongs to a Special Pairing mode.*) Proceed with the instructions.
2. Bring the cellular phone at about 20 cm from the SuperTooth.
3. Turn off the SuperTooth and wait for about 4 seconds.
4. While pressing the **Answer Button**, turn ON the SuperTooth by sliding the **Power Switch** to the right. Keep the **Answer Button** pressed for approximately 10 seconds until you hear a distinctive tone and the Bluetooth indicator LED changes from blinking blue to alternately blinking red and blue. Release the button. The kit is now in handsfree pairing mode. To bring it to special pairing mode, proceed with the instructions.
5. **For Special Pairing mode: After you release the Answer Button, press once the Hang-up Button.** The SuperTooth is now in special pairing mode for Sony Ericsson K700i.
6. While the kit is at pairing mode, access the Bluetooth menu of your phone. Press  (Navigation key) to view Main Menu.
7. Select **Connectivity > Bluetooth > My devices > New device** (press **Add**). The phone will then search for pairable devices until it displays them in the list.
8. Choose **SuperTooth** then press **Select**.
9. When the phone asks for the passcode, enter **0000** then press **Ok**. Wait until pairing is complete. The phone will show briefly on its display – “*SuperTooth Added to My devices*”. The Bluetooth Indicator of kit will change from alternate blinking red/blue to plain blinking blue.
10. Press  as many times as needed to return to standby mode.

The SuperTooth is ready to use.

### ANSWERING / ENDING A CALL

When you receive a call, ring tone will be heard simultaneously on the SuperTooth and on the phone or on the SuperTooth only (*depending on your phone model*).

1. Just shortly press the **Answer Button** to answer the call.
2. To terminate the call, press the **Hang-Up Button**.




### MAKING A CALL



#### **#** Normal dialing

Using your phone, enter the contact number > Call. Audio on Kit.

#### **#** Voice dialing

Make a call by saying a voice name/voice tag. But first, you have to activate and record for a voice command.

1. **Activate Voice Dial:** Press  (Navigation key) to view Main Menu. Select **Settings > Voice control > Voice dialing > Activate**.
2. Press  as many times as needed to return to standby mode.
3. **Record for Voice Dial: (Make sure the number is stored in Phone memory.)**
4. Press  Navigation key to access Main Menu. Select **Settings > Voice control > Voice dialing > Edit names > New voice** (press **Add**). (Contacts list will appear).

5. Choose among the contacts whichever you want to have a voice command. When it's highlighted, press **Select**.
6. Follow the instructions that will be displayed on screen. When your *spoken word(s)* for the recording is caught up by the phone, it will let you to listen to it and then displays the question, “*Is it ok?*”.
7. If you press **Yes** as reply, that voice command will then be saved by the phone. Under **Voice Commands** tab, a callout icon  will appear next to a contact name which has a voice command.
8. Press  as many times as needed to return to standby mode.  
*Note: Record your voice command in a quiet place so that only your voice will be recorded on the phone.*
9. **Execute Voice Dial:** Shortly press **Answer Button** to activate voice dialing.
10. A beep will then be heard on the Kit prompting the user to say the voice command of a person to call.
11. Say the voice command. The voice will be played back to you. The phone will then place the call automatically. In case the phone does not recognize the name spoken, the steps above may be repeated.

### REDIALING

Long press the **Answer Button** to redial the last number.

### AUDIO TRANSFER

**Kit to phone / Phone to Kit:** Shortly press the **Answer button**.

### REJECTING A CALL

Press the **Hang-Up Button** to reject the incoming call.

### SETTING THE VOLUME

Setting the volume can be done using the **Volume Control**.

1. Turn it clockwise to increase the volume.
2. Decrease the volume by turning it counter-clockwise.

*Note: If volume set is too high, it can cause feedback (whistling sound), echo or background noise during calls on some cell phones.*
